General Student Requirements:

- African American (Black) student residing in either Chemung or Steuben County. (College and non-traditional students must be high school graduates of Chemung or Steuben County)
- Maintain, at least, an 80.0 grade average as evidenced by an official school transcript or other official school document. This document should reflect the overall grade average as of the end of the <u>first</u> semester.
- Submit an application package via email between February 1st March 31st
- If selected as a college or non-traditional student recipient, please submit proof of enrollment in a college or vocational school no later than October 1st.
- We will award scholarships to college or non-traditional student recipients after we have received proof of enrollment.
